Message from the Chairman



We have purchased 40 sets of coloured vector bare foot bowls to support our bare foot bowling program using the Queensland Government Sport and Recreation Services Grant we received in January. We are keeping the best of our older black bare foot bowls and will use paint identification 'dots' on the side of the bowls for easier sorting and storage.

Planning is underway for the 2016 Australian Open Championships to be conducted here on the Gold Coast in June. Our Club involvement will centre round the allocation of two Mondays and two Tuesdays during the carnival.

Our Club car parking issues are being addressed on your behalf by Noel Hodges and Peter Hamilton and their car parking requests will be put to the Gold Coast City Council following the upcoming Council elections.



Coaching Notes by Ron



Having now decided what your bowling goals are for the year, your next decision is "how can these goals be achieved?" You must look at your game and current abilities critically to decide where you need improvement, then train in those shots to improve your ability to perform. This training is best carried out either on your own or with help of a coach who will guide you in the right direction without changing how you play. If you choose to continue rolling up with mates it is doubtful that you will improve your ability to play those shots which are holding you back. To improve shot making, you must play a shot over and over again to the point of boredom. This is the disadvantage of using drills to improve, but it has also been proven with many, many bowlers that drills are the best way forward.

Don't neglect the shots which you do play well, or there is a possibility that you will lose some of this ability. I have many drills on paper, too many to include with this article, but if you need a starting point just ask and I will give you a copy. Doing any drill it is important to keep some form of scoring to determine if you are improving, the usual method is to give yourself 1 point for all bowls finishing within a mat length of desired position, not always the jack. Keep a record of these scores to see your improvement week to week, if no improvement, see me. Start your training regime with the simpler drills to build ability and confidence, then move onto the harder drills, its no good starting at a level to which you are aspiring without doing the hard yards to get there.

If you are not keen on doing drills or giving up rolling up with your mate or mates, try incorporating into your rollup those shots which are not among your most consistent. Try as a group to draw 3 bowls to the head then play 1 weighted shot, if this is your need, into the head at a nominated target. If you nominate your shot and consistently don't make it, I am sure you will hear about it and concentrate a bit harder to improve. Vary this type of play to cover the shots you need to improve and include all the shots needed in a game.

Strawberry Shortcake

- 3 pints fresh strawberries
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 4 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/3 cup shortening
- 1 egg
- 2/3 cup milk
- 2 cups whipped heavy cream

Step 1

Slice the strawberries and toss them with 1/2 cup of white sugar. Set aside.

Step 2

Preheat oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C). Grease and flour one 8 inch round cake pan.

Step 3

In a medium bowl combine the flour, baking powder, 2 tablespoons white sugar and the salt. With a pastry blender cut in the shortening until the mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Make a well in the centre and add the beaten egg and milk. Stir until just combined.

Step 4

Spread the batter into the prepared pan. Bake at 425 degrees F (220 degrees C) for 15 to 20 minutes or until golden brown. Let cool partially in pan on wire rack.

Step 5

Slice partially cooled cake in half, making two layers. Place half of the strawberries on one layer and top with the other layer. Top with remaining strawberries and cover with the whipped cream.

Cucumber and Lime Spritzer



INGREDIENTS

- 2 12-ounce cans club soda
- 1/4 cup fresh lime juice (from 3 to 4 limes)
- 1 Kirby cucumber, thinly sliced
