
Finally, I would like to welcome our new receptionist/ administration assistant, Keira.














This month I would like to talk about the use of the mat. Most players were taught to place their feet in the middle of the mat, with toes pointing along the intended delivery line, i.e. toward the shoulder point of delivery, although many players have never followed this advice, so that at a later stage, they can shift around on the mat to better get around or under blocking bowls.

OK so how do we do this: there are three ways to come around or under a bowl you feel is on your delivery line. (Provided you use the same aiming line i.e. foot position on the mat.)

To come around a bowl. Take your stance on the mat, then move forward three to four inches, this puts the shoulder of the green a little further ahead which will allow your bowl to come around the obstructing bowl.

To come under a bowl. This is the same principle only you move back those three or four inches on the mat.

The second way to come around a bowl. Take your stance as usual on the centre line of the mat then move to the left of the mat, (right hand bowlers, right for left-ies) this will increase the angle allowing your bowl to come around the opponents bowl. Remember the rules say you must have one foot completely on or over the mat at point of delivery so make sure you don't step off the side of the mat.

To come under a bowl. Same principle but move to the other side of the mat, i.e. right for right handers and left for left handers

The third way to achieve the same result. If you prefer and you are completely confident in your own drawing ability, is to take a little more or a little less grass, provided. You must take care with this method as it is easy to also put on a little weight and inadvertently pick up the jack and go down some.

Set up a head with a spare set of bowls and try out the approaches to a common problem to see what suits your delivery style.

I would also like to wish all the members a very Happy Christmas time and hope you all enjoy yourselves and stay safe.





Craft Corner

Christmas Crackers



What you need
A4-size paper
(this can be any type of thin paper similar to wrapping paper)

- Glue gun, glue or Sellotape
- A kitchen roll/toilet rolls
- String or shoelace

Recipe Room

Herb and Walnut Cheese Log



INGREDIENTS

- 150g white castello cheese
- 125g cream cheese
- 2 tbs port, brandy or sherry
- 1 tsp dried chili flakes

• 1/2 cup finely chopped mixed soft herbs (such as parsley, chives and basil)

• 1/3 cup finely chopped

- toasted walnuts
- Melba toast or crispbread, to serve

- A snap
- Decorations
- Gifts, novelty toys or jokes

Method

1. Divide the A4-size paper into three by scoring it lightly. Cut up the kitchen-roll barrel into three parts, ensuring that one piece is slightly larger than the others. This will form the central part of the cracker

2. Tape or glue the snap, only sticking the ends to the paper to make sure it'll snap. Place the three parts of the barrel in the centre of each section of the paper

METHOD

Step 1

Whiz cheeses and alcohol in a processor with salt and pepper until smooth.

Step 2

Mix chili with herbs and nuts, then sprinkle on a 30cm piece of plastic wrap, leaving a 2cm border.

Step 3

Spoon cheese along one end of herbs. Lift wrap and roll cheese away from you into a log, pressing gently to coat well in herbs.

Step 4

Twist ends of wrap to seal, then chill for 1-2 hours. Serve with toast 3. Using a tight grip and rolling away from yourself, roll the paper onto the barrel, tucking in the edges neatly. Then glue or tape the seam of the cracker

4. Using a piece of string, tie around the paper at the ends of the central section in the paper to create a neck at either end of the cracker (not to tight you that you cant put the gifts inside)

5. Add gifts to the cracker by dropping them carefully into one end. Personalise your crackers by adding decorations such as bows and Ribbons

Passionfruit Champagne Cocktails



INGREDIENTS

375ml (1 1/2 cups) passionfruit pulp125ml (1/2 cup) brandy1 x 750ml bottle chilled Champagneor sparkling white wine

METHOD

Step 1

Spoon the passionfruit pulp among twelve 30ml ice-cube trays. Place in the freezer for 4 hours or until firm.

Step 2

Pour the brandy among serving glasses. Top with Champagne or sparkling wine and passionfruit ice cubes. Serve immediately.
