# Coaching Notes by Ron



Pennant season is here!!! I hope you are all training hard, not just relying on match play, but also playing those shots you need to be able to play with confidence and precision. You need to focus on your delivery, if you get line and weight right you will finish in the spot you aimed to be. Have a good understanding of your position in the team, if you are new to pennant, chances are you will not have been in a 4's game before. I have copies of coaching notes setting out the duties of each position so grab one off me. Don't guestion the skip on her/his choice of shot, it is the skip's responsibility to build a head to win shots and prevent going down in big numbers, so play the shot asked. When you walk to the head you will probably be able to see why it was needed, it always looks different from the mat. Don't attack the jack, unless asked to, but rather draw to a position 100-200mm(4-8inches) from the jack, bowls in the head around the jack are what win games. There are times in any game when it is beneficial to move the jack to a position where you have multiple catchers. This can also be dangerous if you chip the jack rather than picking up and following, so be careful. You should only concern yourself with those things over which you have control. If you have confidence in your own ability to play any shot you are asked to and focus all your mind on playing those shots you need not worry about what your opponent is likely to do, let them worry about that. As part of a team you need to support your fellow team members, applaud good shots, don't knock poor shots - nobody tries to bowl badly. Be aware of how your rink is doing on the score board and observe how the other rinks in your team are doing. If one is down, lift your own game to cover the shortfall and give the other rink your encouragement to improve their position. This club, as a whole, seems to resent suggestions of training, it is only provided to improve your shot making ability and improve your performance, not to change the way you deliver your bowl. There are clubs where, if you don't attend training you don't play. Good luck during the pennant season and remember the old sporting adage:-

"By failing to prepare, I am preparing to fail".

# CAMELS PLAYER IN PROFILE Denny Edwards





# **CRAFT CORNER**

# **Fabric Snap bags**



# You will need:

Fabric Sewing Machine Tape measure Screwdriver **Old Scissors** Electrical tape

# Step 1.

Cut two pieces of fabric to be the same size. 6" x12" is a good size. Then place them right sides together.



# Step 2.

Step 3.

Sew the ends with a 1/4" seam then flip it so the right sides are out. Press with an iron.



Remove screws from tape measure and remove the back carefully as tape can unravel.



# Step 4.

Using bad scissors (they'll never be the same) cut your tape to the length you need

(5.5" if making a 6" wide bag) and round the corners. Then wrap ends with tape.



### Step 5.

Make a casing for the tape and slide it in. To work right, the back of

the tape measure needs to be towards outside of the bag.



# Step 6.

Fold right sides to-

gether and sew up the sides. Zig zag the edges to keep them from fraying, and then turn the bag right side out.

# **Lemon Blossom** Slice



# **Ingredients**

- •1 1/2 cups plain flour
- •1/3 cup icing sugar
- •1/3 cup cornflour
- •180g butter, diced small
- •1 can (395g) condensed milk
- •1/2 cup lemon juice
- •2 eggs
- •1/3 cup castor sugar
- •1/3 cup coconut

# Method

# Step 1.

Preheat oven to 180°C. Line an rectangular cake tin (20cm '31cm) with foil and spray with baking spray, set aside.

### Step 2.

In a medium bowl add plain flour, icing sugar, cornflour and butter.

### Step 3.

Crumble butter with dry ingredients to form a dough. When combined, press into the tray and bake for 15 minutes. While the base is baking, make filling.

# Step 4.

Add condensed milk, lemon juice and egg yolks together. When it becomes thick and even in texture, pour over precooked base.

# Step 5.

For the meringue topping, whisk egg whites until thick then gradually add castor sugar. Once egg whites are glossy and stiff turn off beaters and fold in coconut.

# Step 6.

Spread evenly over filling and bake for a further 15 minutes.

# Step 7.

Allow to Cool and cut into slices. Store in fridge.
