Message from the Chairman

•The Club congratulates Jake Fehlberg on his selection for the Australian Blind Bowlers tournament to be held in New Zealand in 2016. The Board has donated \$1,000 towards his travelling expenses.

•Club Renovations of the Bar, Reception, Main Foyer stairs and the gaming lounge will be completed by Wednesday 20th May.

•The Club will only open close on Monday 4th and reopen Tuesday 5th May with entry being restricted via the ramped southern door/back entry.

•The Club will be closed on Monday 1st June to permit the laying of our new club house carpet unless delivery is delayed by unforseen circumstances..

•I apologise for the continuing renovation disruptions to our members and guests but by the 5th June the club renovations are proposed to be completed.

•A 'Grand Opening' of the newly renovated 'Burleigh Bowls Club' is scheduled for Thursday 2nd July commencing at 5.00pm for drinks and nibbles. All of our Club members are cordially invited to attend and will be entitled to two complimentary standard drinks.

•The club house roof leaks are being repaired in stages starting with sealing roof penetration from equipment stand in the sheet metal area directly located above the bar store room to prevent any further ingress of water. Covers are being manufactured and installed for the various air conditioning unit roof penetrations and drainage is being improved from the submerged northern roof gutter.

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The control of weight and the ability to visualise the path of your bowl are probably the most important points in playing good, consistent bowls. As a new bowler you had so many thoughts racing through your head to ensure your delivery was smooth and repeatable, that your weight control was somewhat hit and miss. Once you have developed your delivery to the point where you really don't think about it's mechanics, you need to train your muscles and senses to deliver correct weight. Most players were taught weight control initially by control of arm speed or from the elevation theory, the higher the start point the longer and faster the swing. However your body has inbuilt sensors and a rather powerful computer called the brain, train the brain to compute speed.

Elite bowlers prepare for a delivery by visualising the path of the bowl and the bowl finishing it's run exactly where required. They develop a "feel" for the delivery from the weight of the bowl, their perceptions of the pace of green, and senses in their bowling arm and shoulder. This takes a lot of practice and concentration on the "feel" of a delivery. Such rehearsal provides a mental pattern for their largely automatic delivery movement to produce the bowl speed required. They use hand and eye coordination for intuitively integrating gravity force with muscular force in executing the movement.

A corrective delivery for a bowl finishing 1 metre short of it's target requires only 2 ^{1/2} more revolutions of the bowl to be perfect. You need to make this slight variation by "sensing" the extra bowl speed rather than by deliberately deciding to change your delivery mode. You should have trained your body to produce this result, so let your subconscious mind do it's job without interference from you.

You will need to be able to visualise the path travelled by your bowl in the run to the jack to be able to play trail and other through the head shots. Bowl a bowl to the jack, walk up it's track and place some form of markers on this line, go back to the mat and draw another bowl, chasing it to the jack and observe how far out your imagined track was. You will probably have imagined that you saw your bowl turn in much later and more steeply angled to the centre line than actually happened. This observation will allow you to correct your visualization of your bowl's track and allow you to make small width adjustments to draw into and through the head. When delivering the bowl focus your whole being on the process of delivery, have a pre delivery routine, say, step onto mat knowing what you want to achieve, take a deep breath to relax the shoulder muscles, check the bowl is on the correct hand, breath in on the back swing and exhale on delivery. This routine will help you focus on what you are doing, not on what you hope will happen. Then you can begin to follow the bowl's track and observe it's fate, did you do what you intended or not, whichever way it went, learn from the delivery.

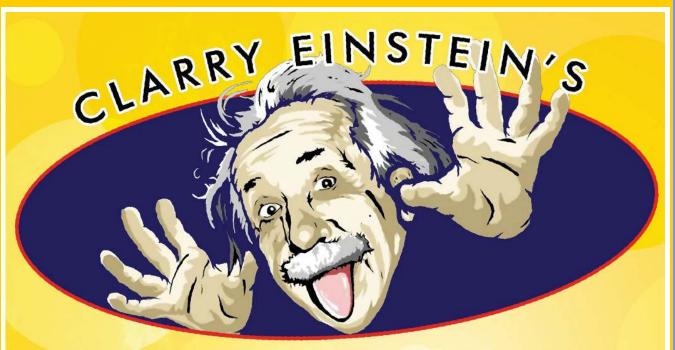

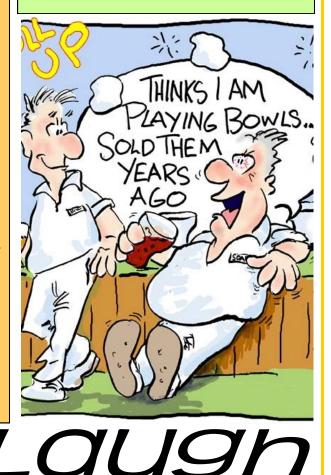

Preheat oven to 200°C/180°C fan-forced. Spoon mixture into a 6 cup-capacity ovenproof dish. Top with pastry, trimming excess. Brush pastry with egg. Sprinkle with sesame seeds. Bake for 30 minutes or until golden. Serve.
