Club Show Policy

Background

The Club conducts a number of show nights every year for our members, guests and Bonafide visitors. These shows are predominantly held on Saturday nights with the exception of the New Year Eves show which is conducted on New Years Eve.

During these show nights Bistro on the Green will serve dinner to our show patrons at their show tables and to those patrons that have reserved a table for a meal in the bistro area of the Club.

Club Show Policy

1. The Club will be closed on all show nights with limited entry permitted after 7.30pm for show patrons and those patrons who have previously reserved a table for dinner in the bistro.
2. Show reservations and bookings will be available at reception for \$10 per patron.
3. No show ticket refunds are permitted.
4. Purchasing a show ticket guarantees the patron a designated seat at a table for the show.
5. Shows will commence at 7.30pm.
6. Teenagers will only be permitted to attend the show nights provided they remain under the strict supervision of their parent (s).
7. Patrons using our Gaming facilities at 7.30pm may remain in the Gaming area and will not be charged the \$10 booking fee.
8. Club bowlers, in uniform, are requested to vacate the Club by 6.30pm.
9. Patrons attending the shows must observe the dress requirements of the Club.
10. The Club Executive Manager will ensure that the proposed show night on duty Bar manager is informed who will be the designated Board member.

Coaching Notes by Ron



I thought this month I would discuss the "Constants" and "Variables" in delivery styles and why it's important to allow players to vary their delivery style from the older perceived "Correct Way" to deliver. If you watch the world's top bowlers there are those who you would say shouldn't be able to perform as they do, but look at Jeremy Henry, impossible delivery to replicate but a world champion. So what governs the delivery, the constants, if you look for them they are within every champions style, but the variations are enormous. Not everyone can pendulum swing with a straight back/straight forward motion, nor can everyone get down as low as they should so we must recognise the limitations a person's body, shape, flexibility, past injuries etc., places on their movement capability. The fundamental basics of a good consistent delivery are:-

Intended line - being able to bowl on the intended desired line

Balance and Stability - remaining balanced and stable during delivery

Controlled Momentum - ensuring the back swing, follow-through, step and forward momentum produce the desired length of delivery.

Smooth Release - delivering the bowl and ensuring the release facilitates little (if any) wobble or bounce

Consistent Repetition - above all else being able to repeat the action.

Within all the above there are the variables which come into play, not everyone can place their anchor foot on the mat with the toe pointing along the intended line and bring their other foot up to it prior to stepping along that line. Some people's feet are not placed parallel to each other so they must point the centre of their body along the line, hips and shoulders square to the intended line. Balance at delivery is also variable, some stand with feet together, some with feet a few inches apart and others with feet well spread, what ever feels right for you is right. Keeping the head still with the eyes looking along your intended delivery line and using a slow deliberate backswing combined with a good down position and follow-through will also help your balance. You can't vary controlled momentum much, although many bowlers don't have a good backswing but push from the knee, they would be better served by developing a good backswing. The smooth release again shouldn't vary, ensure bowl is vertical and pointing along the line and release is as low to the surface as possible and some 3-5 inches ahead of the front toe and bowl will look and feel good as it leaves the hand. The most important point of all develop a delivery within the above framework which is smooth and completely repeatable, don't have a jerky delivery or your weight control will be non-existent and practice till you don't have to think about the mechanics of the delivery. Don't over analyse each delivery you make which doesn't do exactly as you want just get back on the mat and deliver as you have trained. Remember the old adage:- "Go Down, Slow Down, Stay Down"

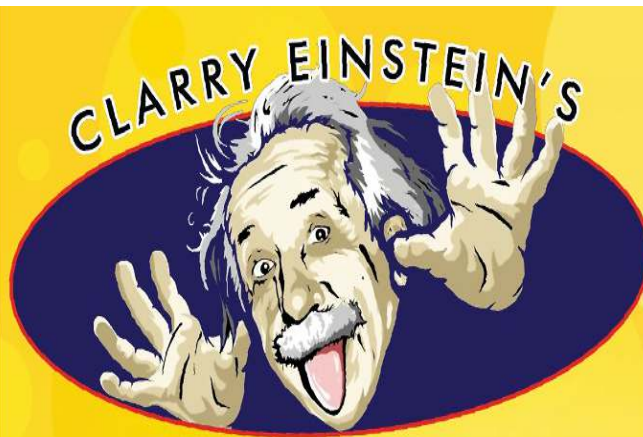

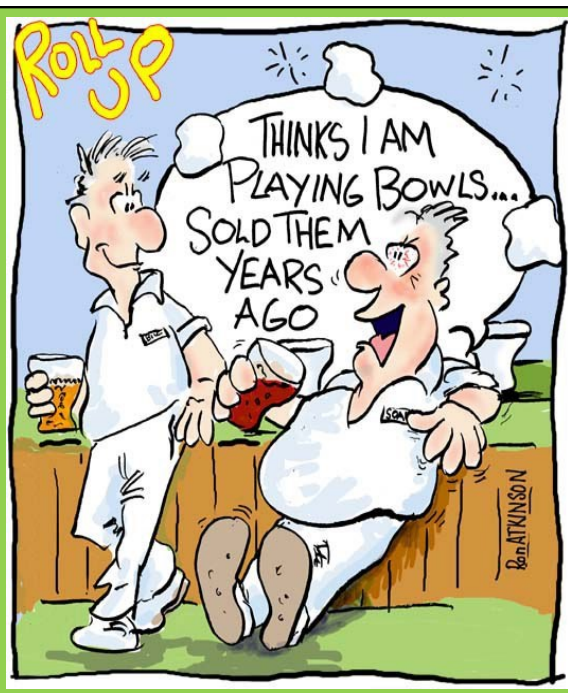

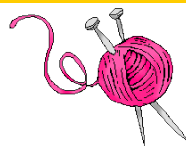

CRAFT CORNER

DIY FATHER'S DAY GIFT

Necktie glasses case



What you will need:

Necktie
Scissors
Needle and thread
Seam ripper
Pins
Velcro dots
Fabric glue

Instructions

1. Lay the necktie flat, backside facing up. Place your folded glasses on top. The top of the glasses should line up with the inside of the tie. Fold the rest of the tie over the glasses, and cut it so it extends 1" beyond the top of glasses.



2. Fold 1" of the cut edge toward the back of the tie and whipstitch it in place. If the tie's internal padding sticks out, turn that under as you stitch.



3. If tie has hand sewn center seam — remove some of this seam. Use a seam ripper to remove the stitching.



4. You only need to remove enough stitching to accommodate your glasses. If your tie has a label, you will need to remove that too.

5. Set your glasses aside and fold the tie as shown. Pin the 2 layers together and hand-sew them along both sides with a hemstitch or a tiny whipstitch.



Stitch only through the topmost layers of fabric — you don't want to sew the front and back of your case together!

6. Fold the tip of the tie over to make a flap. Sew a button on the outside of this flap. Glue velcro dots under the button to hold your case closed. Once the glue is dry, your glasses are good to go.

FATHER'S DAY DINNER

Marinated pork ribs



Ingredients

- 1/2 cup sweet chilli sauce
- 1 1/2 teaspoons grated ginger
- 2 tablespoons salt-reduced soy sauce
- 1/3 cup (80ml) light beer
- 1.25kg pork ribs, cut into large pieces

Method

1. Place the sweet chilli sauce, grated ginger and soy sauce in a large non-metallic bowl. Add the beer, salt and cracked black pepper and stir until well combined. Add the ribs, turning until evenly coated in the marinade. Cover and refrigerate for 3 hours or overnight.

2. Heat a barbecue or large grill to medium-high heat. Drain the ribs from the marinade and reserve the liquid. Cook ribs for 8-10 minutes each side or until cooked through, basting with the reserved liquid occasionally. Transfer to a serving platter and serve with a simple salad, BBQ sauce.

Fried Onion Rings



Ingredients

- 3/4 cup plain flour
- 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 cup soda water
- Vegetable oil, for shallow fry
- 2 medium red onions, sliced

1. Sift flour and baking powder into a large bowl. Season with salt and pepper. Make a well in centre. Gradually whisk in soda water until mixture forms a smooth, thin batter.

2. Add oil to a large frying pan to come 2cm up side of pan. Heat over medium-high heat.

3. Coat onion rings in batter, shaking off excess. Cook, in batches, for 1 to 2 minutes, turning, until golden brown. Transfer onto a baking tray lined with paper towel to drain. Serve immediately.
