Message from the Chairman



Welcome to our new Board members Diane Pickett, Noel Hodges and Brian Bottrell. I am pleased to report that our application for a grant of \$7,200 from the Queensland Government Sport and Recreation Service Grant for the provision of numerous sets of coloured bowls to support our barefoot bowls program was successful.

Planning is underway for the 2016 Australian Open Championships to be conducted here on the Gold Coast in June. Our Club involvement will centre round the allocation of Monday and Tuesdays during the carnival. Both #1 and #2 greens are back in service and I'd like to thank Graeme Shillington, Vince Sullivan and the fantastic effort of the many, many volunteers who made it possible to install the rubber matting on the ditch rebound faces and refurbish the two greens. This great Club would be much the poorer if it was not for the work carried out by these volunteers. Our Club air conditioning sensors have been relocated throughout the Club house to provide more efficient air conditioning operation and better temperature control. Wednesday night Trivia has been reviewed and the teams can now only win one round per night. Equal top scorers in each round will draw a card to decide who gets the prize. Club in house cash vouchers as prizes will continue to be awarded to the winners of each round and for the best team of the night. As announced by our Council Presidents, our mat fees will not increase and additionally there will be an increase in prize money for our bowling members.

Our Club car parking issues are being addressed on your behalf by Noel Hodges and Peter Hamilton with the Gold Coast City Council. Significant research into the drafting of necessary legal and operational amendment to our Club Constitution and Bylaws is well underway. Amendments to various Queensland and Commonwealth Government Acts of Parliament and their associated Regulations, Queensland Liquor Licensing, Queensland Work Place Health and Safety and Bowls Queensland which affect the operation of 'not for profit incorporated clubs' which encompass privacy, discrimination, harassment, smoking DOSA, occupational health and safety etc. have impacted on our current Constitution and Bylaws. A Club Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) will be convened on Monday 18th April 2016 at 9am for voting on the applicable special resolutions. Notices will be posted out and a detailed hand out will be prepared and distributed a month before the EGM to afford our members the opportunity to comment on the proposed amendments. The sealing and painting of the tiled roof section of the Club will be brought forward to this year due to a continuing leak through the eastern section porous tiles.

Finally, with much sadness and on behalf of members and guests, I would like to pass on my sincere thanks to Kristy Gilfillan as she has left the Club. Kristy has worked here for the past 9 years and has given dedicated service and assisted in no small way to the efficient running of our Club administration. She will be dearly missed. I would also like to congratulate Kristy on the birth of her new baby girl Zahlia Rose on 26th January. Mum and bub are healthy and doing well. Wishing Kristy and the family all the best on their new safe arrival.



Coaching Notes by Ron



And so another year begins; a very happy, safe and healthy year to you all. This is a good time to reflect on your game and your goals in the sport for the coming year. I feel it is important that we all set ourselves goals which can be achieved within the space of a year. You really need to write your personal goals down and refer to them often to see if you have made any progress towards achieving your result. These goals should be measurable and realistic, there is little use saying you will be world champion if you haven't put your foot on the bottom rung of the ladder to take you there.

Realistic step by step is the way to go with each step being within the realms of possibility. I know that training drills can become boring because of their repetition, but they are the only proven way to improve the quality of your delivery and hence you're shot making. Start with standard draw drills and gradually interperse these with trail shots, running shots and drives. You do need to have every shot in the book at your disposal. Train your body and mind to play all these shots with the intention of proving your increase in ability to play them correctly every time. You really need to keep a scoring log to see improvement and with repetition you will be able to measure your improvement. At any practice session you need to fully concentrate on your shot making with your utmost ability. Don't be distracted by anything which is going on around you and do not over analyse your delivery, just believe in your own ability to play the shots as you intend and allow your body to play the shot as you see it.

Your goals can be met if they are realistic and you train hard and often enough to achieve them. Nothing comes without effort on your part so set your goals realistically and work hard to achieve them. My personal goal is to help as many of our bowlers as I possibly can to improve their ability this year by assisting them with training regimes. If you need help you need only ask and it shall be given. Remember the old saying: "If you only do what you have always done, you will only get what you always did."

The Camels hit the ground running in 2016 with our annual bring a friend day on Sunday Jan 4 with 12 visitors joining the crew for a great day of bowls!





Craft Corner



Book Jewellery Box

Materials:

- Old Book
- Exacto knife
- Mod Podge
- Small Paint Brush
- Pencil
- Hot Glue Gun
- Silk flowers of your choice.

Method

1. Open the book and draw a rectangle leaving 1/2-1 inch border all the way around the book.
2. Next, using your exacto knife cut a rectangle using the lines already drawn. (You will repeat this step multiple times because of the thickness of the book)
3. You will notice that your book pages won't line up exactly. I think it gives it a bit of a vintage look!



4. Once you have cut all the way through, leave the cover to book up and start Mod Podging every few pages together as well as the outside of the pages and inside of the newly made box.

5. Using your Hot Glue Gun, glue some fake or dried flowers to the top of the book.

6. Once the Mod Podge is dry, you may add some beautiful jewellery to make this project complete!



Recipe Room

Avo and Prawn Salad



INGREDIENTS

- 500g peeled green prawns (tails intact)
- 1 fresh red chilli, finely chopped
- 2cm piece fresh ginger, grated
- 1 garlic clove, crushed
- 2 limes, rind finely grated, juiced
- 60ml (1/4 cup) extra virgin olive oil
- 3 avocados
- 1/3 cup fresh coriander leaves, chopped
- 1/3 cup fresh mint leaves, chopped
- 1 1/2 tablespoons finely chopped fresh chives
- 60ml (1/4 cup) Coconut Milk
- 2 tablespoons water
- 450g papaya, deseeded, into wedges
- 1 iceberg lettuce, cut into wedges
- 2 teaspoons honey
- Toasted macadamias, chopped, to serve

METHOD

STEP 1

Combine the prawns, chilli, ginger, garlic, rind from 1 lime and 1 tbs of the oil in a bowl. Season. Set aside to develop the flavours.

Step 2

Meanwhile, coarsely chop 1 avocado. Process with the coriander, mint, chives and 2 1/2 tbs lime juice in a food processor until almost smooth. Add the coconut milk, water and 1 1/2 tbs of the remaining oil. Season and process until mixture is smooth and well combined.

Step 3

Cut remaining avocados into wedges. Drizzle with a little of the remaining lime juice to prevent discolouration. Arrange with papaya and lettuce on a serving plate.

Step 4

Combine honey and 1 tbs of the remaining lime juice in a bowl. Heat the remaining oil in a large non-stick frying pan over medium-high heat. Cook prawns, turning, for 4 minutes or until prawns change colour and are cooked through. Transfer to a plate. Drizzle with the lime mixture.

Step 5

Top the salad with prawns. Spoon over green goddess dressing. Sprinkle with the macadamia and season.

Strawberry Limeade



Make simple syrup: Dissolve 1 cup sugar in 1 cup water in a saucepan over low heat; let cool. Combine with 1 cup lime juice, 2 cups water, some frozen chopped strawberries and ice.


