Members have raised concerns about the difficulty of entering and exiting the Club via the sliding door adjacent to the games office. Quotations are being sourced to install exit and entry buttons for an automated opening/closing sliding door.

The cement path, next to number 3 green, repair has been authorised and work will commence in the near future.

Polyurethane Tactile Indicators will be installed at the top and bottom of our club front steps.

The adjustment of number 1 green lights is in progress as is the lighting for our recently installed 'shell' and 'lorikeet' signs.

It has come to our notice that the Club Classification (Form 11) regarding our Occupancy Capacity and our Club building plans cannot be located. A building certifier has been engaged to extract a copy of our Club building plans and our current Club classification certificate from the Gold Coast City Council.

## **Club Bingo**

The idea of conducting Bingo in the Club on Monday nights has been raised and the Board is currently investigating the feasibility and associated costs of running Bingo.

#### Y.T.D Analysis

Income up by \$55,279 mainly due to increases in Gaming and Barefoot Bowls, and Govt. Subsidy on Maternity Leave. Decreases were noted in regards to Membership, Bar sales, Keno, Green Fees, Merchandise sales, Sponsorship and Interest on our term deposits.

Expenditure up by \$82,073 mainly due to Advertising, Bar purchases, Gaming pay outs, Live music, Insurance, Levies/Capitation, Trivia, Council rates, Security and Wages.

Decreases were noted in regard to Repairs/Maintenance and Computer systems.

While not our best trading result in recent years, we are still capable of achieving our previously anticipated Net Profit of \$200,00.00 for the year.

## COACHING NOTES BY RON

It's great to see players come to have a roll-up and practice their drawing ability but what are you hoping to achieve? Do you intend perfecting your delivery technique or challenging yourself to learn new deliveries? If it is the former by all means roll-up with a friend, be competitive and concentrate on each delivery and hopefully it will be of benefit to your game. If, on the other hand, you are challenging yourself, pick those shots which you either don't play well or don't play at all and work at them, this is always a solo roll-up. Speed of delivery is possibly the most important aspect to develop because it provides your weight control for the draw to position shots and for the more aggressive shots. Remember the speed at which the bowl travels is in direct proportion to the speed at which your arm moves, therefore you should practice delivery at a specific weight to allow your body to become accustomed to that movement.

To play the through the head shots you will normally need to play with ditch weight and if you miss your shot, provided you can play with the same weight next shot, you will be able to more readily correct your line. You should also practice trailing the jack to a position behind the head, this calls for a shot with some 1 to 2 metres of weight over the draw. It is in fact a draw to another position. You will need a very good mental picture of the line of your bowl to play this shot effectively, it is a good idea to have someone roll your bowls to you to allow you to see how far sideways your bowl moves over the last 2 or 3 metres of its travel. This shape is usually different to that which you perceive from the mat. We therefore have two somewhat different training regimes, one where you are drawing to the jack or to the position bowl and the other where you are developing a delivery speed which will take you into the ditch.

There a couple of exercises to allow this to develop, one is to draw a bowl to any length without a Jack, then draw another 3 bowls within a mat length or width of the first bowl. Score 2 points for each bowl within 1 mat length, 1 point for within 2 mat lengths and nothing for any other. You will need to concentrate on every shot, this is also good practice for any game as you need to be able to shut out everything around you as you deliver. The other weight control exercise I favour is to have 2 jacks, one on the T and the other at the 21 metre mark. Draw 2 bowls forehand to the long jack and 2 bowls forehand to the short jack, coming back the other way on the rink, bowl 2 bowls backhand to the long jack and 2 backhand to the short jack. Scoring is as for the previous exercise.

Keep your scores and endeavour to beat them each time you train and make sure you improve. Another training drill I like is to roll a jack and leave it where it stops, draw 2 bowls forehand, 1 backhand to the jack, then decide to either remove the nearest bowl or the jack with ditch weight. Coming back in the opposite direction draw backhand first then forehand to allow you to develop your own shot with both forehand and backhand. As you practice any of these drills you should also be training your mind to fully concentrate on each shot, doesn't help you if you deliver a bowl with the "doesn't matter if I miss" attitude. In any game every shot is important.

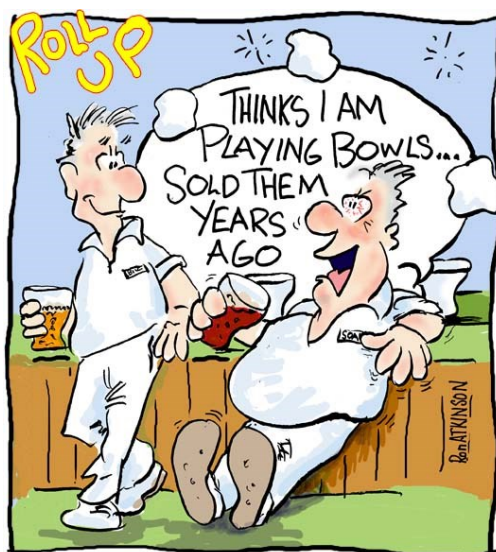

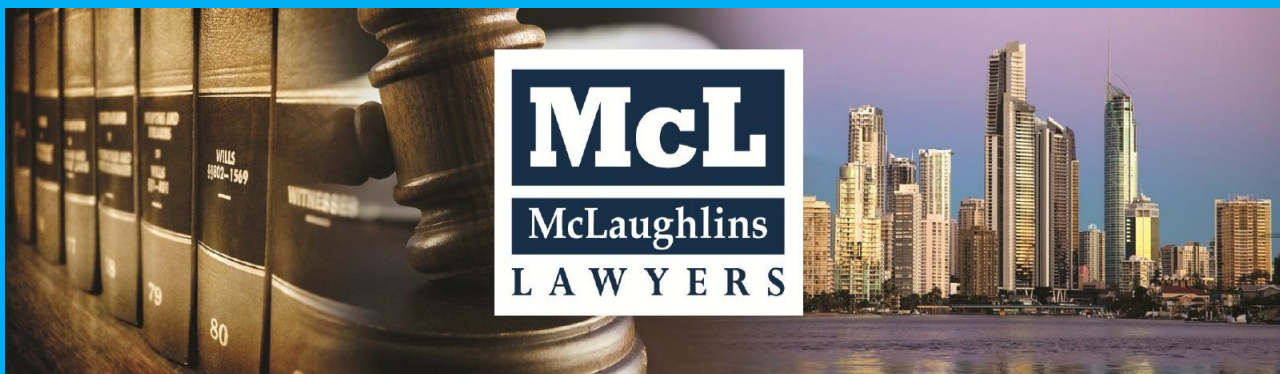
