





MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Club Trading

A detailed analysis of the increasing number of our Club Competitors and a review of our Club trading comparison to that of last year was completed in July. The analysis showed a levelling off of our Club trading particularly from our bar sales.

Club Culture and Customer Service

In an endeavour to significantly raise the standard of our Club customer service and implement changes to our Club culture, the Board enlisted the services of a hospitality training company to conduct a culture and customer service workshop. The Board members, Club managers and staff attended the workshop and together we recognised the need to change our existing Club culture and encourage the delivery of outstanding customer service.

Club Updating and Maintenance

The introduction of the new Australian \$5 notes in September will require a possible, costly replacement of our two 'Abacas' note counting machines due to the current 'Abacas' machines not being able to identify the new \$5 notes.

The Club has two EFTPOS terminals at present located at the bar and reception which need to be upgraded so we can connect them to the SWIFTPOS accounting system. The Club will purchase software to link Metropolis and EFTPOS together. The reception EFTPOS system is used to pay for a number of items such as memberships, barefoot bowls, men's merchandise, show ticket sales etc. whilst the bar EFTPOS system is for bar sales and other men's merchandise.

Another under ground water leak has been detected by the Green Keeper in the vicinity of #3 green and repairs will be carried out next Monday.

Club Volunteers

The Men's council urgently needs volunteers to help in the Club and to sell raffle tickets on Wednesday and / or Friday nights for a couple of hours. I urge anyone interested in volunteering to immediately contact Bruce McGregor or Jim Wadling for details.

Club Interim Financial Report

Club Interim Financial Report:

The Club year to date trading income for 2016 is \$1,921,758 compared to \$1,943,407 in 2015. A difference of \$21,649 or \$2,405 less income per month.

This is a very reasonable result considering the increased opposition in close proximity to our Club. Our Club expenditure of \$1,995,208 is an increase of \$126,977 for the same period last year. The increase in expenditure is primarily, due to increases in advertising, electricity consumption, gaming payouts, greens maintenance and equipment upgrades, live music, provision of long service leave and superannuation, members entertainment (Foxtel) and staff wages.

The increased expenditure has been closely monitored by the Board and is considered to be neither extravagant or ill considered. Club total cash at bank was \$1,249,689 in October 2015 and is now \$1,029,029 at July 2016.

Our Bar Profit for the year to date is down \$21,809 and the Board of Management has decided that as a result of recently increased freight charges and the upcoming August liquor excise increase, the price of all alcoholic drinks affected by the excise increase will rise by 20 cents per glass as from the 1st August 2016.

COACHING NOTES BY RON

I intended talking at length this month on the technicalities of the delivery, but it's a subject which I don't believe would be interesting to many readers, so I would like to have a word about using the bowling arm. There are players in this, and many other, clubs who have reached a point in the life of their bodies, where they can no longer lunge down into a position from which a bowl can be delivered without a dump. This is an unfortunate fact of life and should not be ignored. If you force your body to go beyond the point where discomfort becomes pain you have gone too far. It is not a reflection on your ability to admit that the time has come, for the sake of your well being and the condition of the greens, to consider using a bowling arm. However, before you decide to either give up or admit to yourself that you could be better off, try one out. We have a finger grip release model in the coach's box and there are two other types, so try before you buy. Talk to those who have taken this path and possibly try out their arm to get a small feel for how it could help your body. There are three distinctly different means of releasing the bowl, from 3 different manufacturers, they are the "Bionic Bowler" which has a thumb release, a "Bowling Arm" with a finger gripped release and a DHB with a finger tip trigger. The one I have available is the Bowling Arm, but look around the club and you will also find the other two. Talk to the people who use them.

There is no longer the sideways look delivered at the bowler

who needs to use this type of equipment, I would rather see bowling arms than no players. The thumb release arm allows the bowler to depress the release mechanism purely with the press of the thumb, which should be comfortable, unless you have arthritis in the thumb joint, which is also one of the reasons you needed to stop using your long time grip on the bowl. The finger gripped release requires the bowler to squeeze the grip to hold the bowl and relax that grip at delivery, as you open the hand to release the arm descends toward the green surface and requires you to have the correct length of arm any impact on the hand or joints therein would be on the knuckles, again arthritis could become a problem. The trigger release is below the handle and requires the fingers to drop away from the trigger to release the bowl. Have not yet tried this arm but it would appear to be the most ergonomically satisfactory. Using the arm produces а controllable and almost perfect pendulum swing and with practice should enable the bowler to regain their ability to bowl correctly. Before you give up bowling, because it either hurts or you feel you have lost your competitiveness, try an arm.


