Club Bowling Membership

The 2017 Bowling Membership renewal notices have been prepared and are now available from reception. Your Membership can now be paid in person at reception by cash, cheque or EFTPOS.

Club Maintenance

The refurbishment and replacement of the Bistro storage area and Bistro cool room shelving has now been completed.

During the wild storms in June several of our roof mounted solar panels suffered water ingress. The solar panel manufacturer has replaced **all** of the solar panels. Following requests by our bowlers, the worn out / damaged bowls polisher lamb's wool covered rollers will be replaced with new lamb's wool covered rollers. The efforts of two of our members, Don Bode and Gary Pearson have not gone unnoticed in maintaining the cleanliness, appearance and functionality of our Club House — thank you both.

Club Shows and Club patronage

Our 2016 Club Shows including the recent BEE GEEs show have been sold out and our Club patronage as a result has increased. From the Board of Management, I'd like to take this opportunity to personally thank the bar and reception staff for the outstanding customer service they provided for our show patrons throughout the BEE GEEs show – well done.

The next Club Show to be held on Saturday October 1st is the 'Bobby Darin Show' featuring the 12 piece band 'Swingforce' and again, the tickets are selling very fast. The Club Bistro \$10 lunch meals have proven to be very successful and I thank the Caterer for the standard, quality and variety of the lunch meals and also his staff for their friendly, efficient customer service.

Changes to the 'Tobacco Laws in Queensland'

From the 1st September 2016 the Qld Government has introduced 11 new smoking restrictions. The Board of Management is in the process of updating our Club Smoking Management Plan and revising our Club 'Designated Outdoor Smoking Area' in order to comply with government legislation and the wishes of the vast majority of our non-smoking members.

Greens and Surrounds

Our greens, green's surrounds and external equipment are a 'sight for sore eyes'. Trevor, Vince and Keith have done a great job in a short period of time to resurrect the look of the place and in particular, the bowling speed of #1 green - thank you.

Soft Drink Sales

Following many, many complaints from our members, the Board of Management has investigated the price of soft drinks purchased from the bar and at the next Board Meeting the Board of Management in conjunction with the Bar Manager will decide on the price of soft drinks purchased from the bar.

Card-it

Card-it has arrived for our Gaming patrons. There are easy to use instructions at reception and at the cashier. If you don't wish to use Card-it when on the machines, please see reception to disable this facility. You are still able to just use cash or you can load cash onto your card.

If you swipe your card at the front kiosk, you won't need to enter a pin number at the machines if you go from the kiosk to the gaming machines within 5 minutes. The PIN number is set as the last four digits of your card number. If your card/ member number has only two or three numbers then put zeros in front to make up four numbers. You should immediately reset your PIN number to something only you know, for security purposes. Your PIN number enables card/ cash play. If you don't enter your PIN you still accumulate points. For every dollar spent at the bar, you receive 1 point.

For every ten dollars turned over in gaming, you receive 1 point. If you win \$100 and play that out, then you will receive points for the gambling of that \$100. 1 point is equal to one cent.

Points can be redeemed at the cashier for cash or drinks or at the kiosk by tickets which will need to be cashed at the bar for \$5, \$10, \$20 or \$50 at a time. You are able to store up to \$9999 on Club cards. If you would prefer to be anonymous, you are welcome to use anonymous cards (held at the cashier section of the bar or at reception. The limit which can be stored on those cards is \$5000. Anonymous cards expire after 48 hours of the last use but you are still able to see the cashier to take your money out after this.

Always press take win then collect and check for zeros before removing your card from the machine.

The maximum load from your card to machine is set at \$199.99. If you would like to set a smaller amount, please speak to the cashier. The card can, for example, be set to only allow \$20 to come down at a time.

Money unclaimed within 12 months of the last use of an ANONYMOUS card, will be sent to Office of Liquor Gaming and Racing (OLGR) for holding until claimed. Money left unclaimed for more than 12 months on Member cards will be sent by cheque to your latest registered address.

Member cards and points expire 30th September annually.

COACHING NOTES BY RON

There are, considered by coaches, to be 10 common faults which detract from a bowler's performance. The possible causes and suggested remedies are in most cases as follows:-WOBBLE: Obvious as the bowl moves away from you it is not running smoothly. CAUSE: Gripping the bowl too tightly between thumb and fingers, not having bowl aligned correctly in the hand, loose wrist. REMEDY: Correct grip to a relaxed position in the finger tips, ensure bowl is standing vertically in the hand, keep wrist and elbow locked until bowl has been delivered and follow through completed.

NARROW BOWL: Not maintaining delivery line, bowling narrow. CAUSE: Stepping foot incorrectly placed, rolling wrist, shoulders not square to delivery line. REMEDY: Ensure foot poition on mat is correct, look along delivery line, step along delivery line, not across it, keep wrist locked.

SHORT BOWL: CAUSE: Over stepping and delaying release of bowl. Lifting head at delivery point and delivering behind front toe instead of ahead. Weight on back, or anchor, foot instead of front foot, hooked arm, no follow through, or perhaps fear of giving away a shot. REMEDY: Ensure step length is correct, release bowl 50-75mm ahead of front toe, this ensures weight is forward, lock wrist and elbow and ensure a full follow through.

IMBALANCE: Unsteady delivery and feeling of falling at delivery. CAUSE: Incorrect foot positioning on mat and stepping. REMEDY: Ensure feet are separated by some 100mm to give base width. Step straight forward as walking step not on a tightrope, have 85% of weight on front foot. Ensure non bowling hand grips front knee to balance body.

ERRATIC GRASS LINE: Delivery line inconsistent and not where intended.

CAUSE: Not bowling where you think you are looking, bowling over a point too close to mat, not standing on the mat in a consistent manner. REMEDY: Always line feet up with your aiming line in the same position on the mat. Look out to either a perceived crown position of your delivery ine or a bank position or a spot on the green surface and ensure you bowl on that line. Above all CONCENTRATE.

LOSS OF WEIGHT CONTROL: CAUSES: Cocking wrist, flipping, whipping arm back into backswing and pushing. REMEDY: Drop the hand to get the thumb as near as possible to be in the line of the arm. With the fingers thus behind the bowl there is less chance of flipping. Allow the mass of the bowl to take the arm back in the backswing and forward to delivery. Control the starting elevation of the bowl to obtain consistent length. The delivery must be smooth without any jerking.

DUMPING BOWL: CAUSE: Not getting down close to the surface, releasing bowl too far forward. REMEDY: Go down, slow down, stay down. If you cannot physically get down try bending a little more sideways to get the shoulder lower, if this cannot be done, refer to last months notes re bowling arms. Ensure the front knee is ahead of the front toe at delivery, bowl will then be released at bottom of down swing and at correct height from surface.

<u>ILL DISCIPLINED DRIVING:</u> CAUSE: Attempting to drive too fast, too much body influence, loss of balance and wrong placement of feet.. REMEDY: Use fast but controlled weight with larger than normal backswing. Stand with anchor foot toward the side of mat such that the arm will swing along the line.
