#### **Message from the Chairman**

#### **Club Trading**

I am concerned that after 6 months of this financial year the Club is currently trading marginally in the red and surviving on accumulated reserves. In recognition of our 'flat' trading, the Board of Management has since December, cut all spending except for our normal operating costs and ongoing repairs and maintenance to our Club and equipment.

Thanks to the significant efforts being put in by the Board members and various Club Committees on your behalf we are endeavouring to compete against the increasing local licensed outlets and community clubs.

Whilst our patronage has increased primarily due to our bare foot bowls, bi monthly shows, the monthly rock and roll shows, Wednesday and Friday night raffles and member's draws, weekly trivia and improved customer service, unfortunately the available dollars to spend by our local populace will only spread so far.

Based on this current 'flat trading' trend, the Board Treasurer and I are of the opinion that at best, the Club by September will trade marginally in the black. In these very trying times it behoves on all of our members to support their Club in order to help reverse this ongoing trend.

#### **Club Air Conditioning**

We have received the air conditioning engineer's report and recommendations and were pleased to learn that we can achieve our Club air conditioning aims at a reasonable cost.

Briefly, our existing air conditioning plant is capable of servicing our Club for several more years.

The major influx of hot air through our external Club doors can be significantly reduced by ensuring the kitchen exhaust hood and make up air are simultaneously switched on thereby maintaining a slight pressure differential within the Club.

The different temperatures within the Club and the recycling of stale internal air can be overcome by introducing outside air via our two air conditioning systems.

The other area of concern is the gaming room which will require the installation of two split units to combat the heat generated by the gaming machines and to provide a constant cool temperature throughout the gaming lounge.

These two minor upgrades (kitchen exhaust and outside air) and the installation of gaming room split systems will need to be carried out before next summer.

#### **Number 1 Green**

Number 1 green will be back in service from 1st April. On behalf of our bowling members I would like to take this opportunity to thank Trevor, Vince and Keith for their outstanding efforts in restoring not only the green but the surrounds, garden beds and shades – well done.

#### **Termites**

Earlier this month our vigilant bar staff discovered that some termites were devouring a XXXX Gold carton full of beer in the keg area (the beer was saved!!!). Our pest contractor revealed that this was a local infestation and successfully treated and baited the area. However, he noted that the soil in this area was very damp and ideal for termites. Two leaks were detected (eastern end of #3 green and under the Club house, and fixed. Inspection revealed that significant condensation on the underfloor beer pipes was dripping down onto the soil causing the damp soil area. We are currently waiting for advice on how to contain and remove this condensation.





Further investigation has found that the current air vents that permit a flow of air through the underfloor area of the Club are far too small and need to be enlarged thereby ensuring a sufficient flow of air under the floor to keep the soil dry.

#### **Parking**

After a lot of effort by several members of the Club who lobbied to strike a parking deal for our bowlers benefit with the GCCC, it was extremely disappointing to learn on the 20th March that from 27th March the GCCC was introducing changes to parking in Burleigh Heads.

#### **Coaching Notes by Ron**

There are a number of things you should be aware of when you are in control of the head. The rules say you must be a minimum of 2metres behind the jack, therefore if jack is on T you must be on the bank. Don't stand immediately behind the jack, white shoes and white jack can blend into one, so stand about 1metre to the side of line to jack, this also allows your opponent to have a fair view of the rink and delivery approaching. You can stand within the head if indicating where a bowl should finish, provided you move away as soon as the bowl has been delivered.

Make sure you stand still and don't wave your arms around, this can be very distracting for the player on the mat. If a bowl runs into the head and disturbs bowls it is your responsibility to ensure they do not travel into an adjoining head, always remove bowls which end up too wide and therefore off the rink. Remember that you lose control of the head as soon as the bowl stops, at this point the next bowler can be on the mat and ready to bowl, have a look at the head after his bowl is on the way.

If a bowl in its course touches the jack the rules indicate that it must be marked before the next bowl is delivered, however in social bowls this rule is often ignored but if you are playing pennant make sure you mark before the next bowl. At the change over, end to end of players and

skips, don't hang around near the head trying to decide shots while the first skip is on the mat waiting to play. Skips should remember that it is the unwritten rule for the skip who delivers the second last bowl to pick up the mat after the last skip has played.

To save wear and tear on the green surface at the bank ends, only those two players who have control of the head should be on the green. All other members of the team on the bank, I know you see on TV the whole of two teams standing behind the head, that is only for TV. Leads should be aware if the skip want the mat placed in a specific spot and jack delivered to a particular length, so look at your skip for direction before you kick bowls.

When standing behind the bowler on the mat it is etiquette to not stand closer than 1 metre and to remain still and quiet. All the other points of etiquette you were taught when you first started bowls apply at all times and in all positions.

Consideration to your opponents and your team creates a great atmosphere in which to play and enjoy our great game.
